

Karin Writzl, MD, PhD

Karin Writzl is a Clinical Geneticist and Laboratory Geneticist at the Clinical Institute of Genomic Medicine, University Medical Centre Ljubljana, and an Associate Professor at the Medical Faculty of the University of Ljubljana. She combines clinical practice, teaching, and research, with a primary focus on dysmorphology and cardiogenetics.

She completed training in clinical genetics and laboratory genetics at the University Medical Centre Ljubljana. She also gained additional experience in clinical genetics and laboratory genetics during training periods at Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children (London), Universitätsklinikum Jena (Germany), and The University of Montpellier (France).

She has been actively involved in advancing clinical genetics both in Slovenia and at the European level. She served as Secretary General/Deputy Secretary General of the European Society of Human Genetics from 2013 to 2024. She was president of the Slovenian Association of Medical Genetics (2008-2010, 2014-2019) and chaired the Advisory Body for Medical Genetics at the Slovenian Ministry of Health. Since 2017, she has represented Slovenia as a delegate to the European Union of Medical Specialists - Section of Medical Genetics.
